

RULES.

1. That the Club shall be called the Border City Wheelers C. C.
2. That the Management shall consist of Secretary, Treasurer, Chairman, Captain, and 3 Members, elected at the Annual General Meeting.
3. That a Committee Member who misses two successive Meetings, without reasonable excuse shall be expelled from Committee.
4. That only first claim Members shall be eligible to serve on Committee.
5. That Professionals shall not be allowed to hold Official positions.
6. That Subscriptions shall be 6/- . Ladies and Youths under 20. 4/-
7. That new Members joining after Sept. 30th need pay no more Subscriptions until Dec. 31st the year following.
8. That all Members who have not paid their Subscriptions by March 31st shall resign from Membership, and renounce all claims on the Club.
9. That applications for Membership shall be referred to the Committee.
10. That the Committee may expel any member guilty of unseemly conduct and such members shall forfeit all claims on the Club.
11. That a Special General Meeting may be called by Committee, Secretary, or by 7 Members. Seven days notice shall be given, and Agenda must accompany notice.
12. That the Rules of the Road must be observed.
13. That the Club be affiliated to R.T.T.C. N & D.S.A. F.C.U. N.W.T.T.A. and C.S.Y.

RACING RULES.

1. All entry fees must be paid before being allowed to compete.
2. A minimum of three entries before a race shall be held.
3. In Club events the prizes shall be 1st, 2nd, and 3rd fastest, and 1st, 2nd, and 3rd handicap excepting when 12 or less entries are received, when no 3rd prize will be given. The one man one prize rules will operate in Club events, with the exception that the Tiffen Cup goes to the first handicap winner in the Club 25 irrespective of any other prize he may gain. (Club Certificates will be awarded to members gaining no other award whose time in the Club "50" is within 12 minutes of that of the winner, and in the Club "100" 30 minutes of that of the winner) in abeyance.
4. The Club Championship will be decided on the B.B.A.R. System at 25, 50, & 100 miles Club events only to count, an award also being given to the runner up.
5. Club Standards (In abeyance.)
6. Championship Trophy, Open individual 2 Team cups, 100 cup and Tiffen cup, shall be competed for annually and shall be retained by winner for one year only, also Sewell Trophy, Hardman Trophy, Club 50 Shield, and Junior Championship Shield.
7. That a first claim member be one who at the time of his election was not a member of any other cycling Club or who since the time of his election has resigned from these clubs of which he was a member, at the date of his election.
8. That any member to be eligible to ride for any club prize, or as a representative of the club in open road events, shall be a first claim member.
9. That handicap prizes in club events be goods to the value prescribed, a member having the option of a plain medal for any handicap prize, but no such medal to cost more (including inscription) than the value fixed by the Committee.

11. That all racing members shall make themselves acquainted with the rules of the Road Time Trials Council.
12. That the handicapping of all club events be in the hands of the Handicapper.
